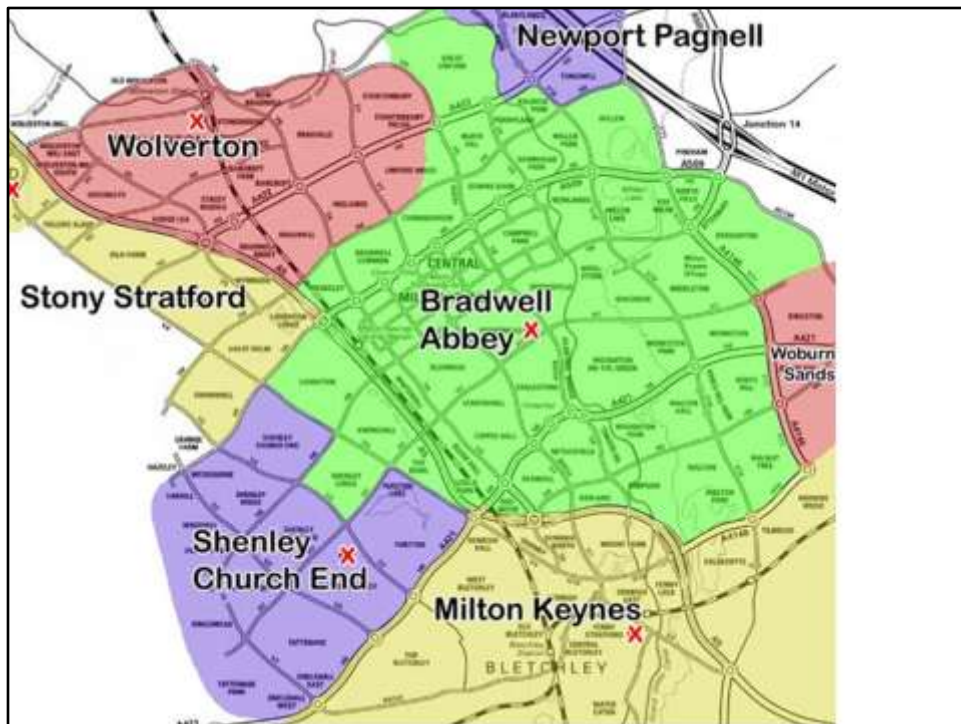


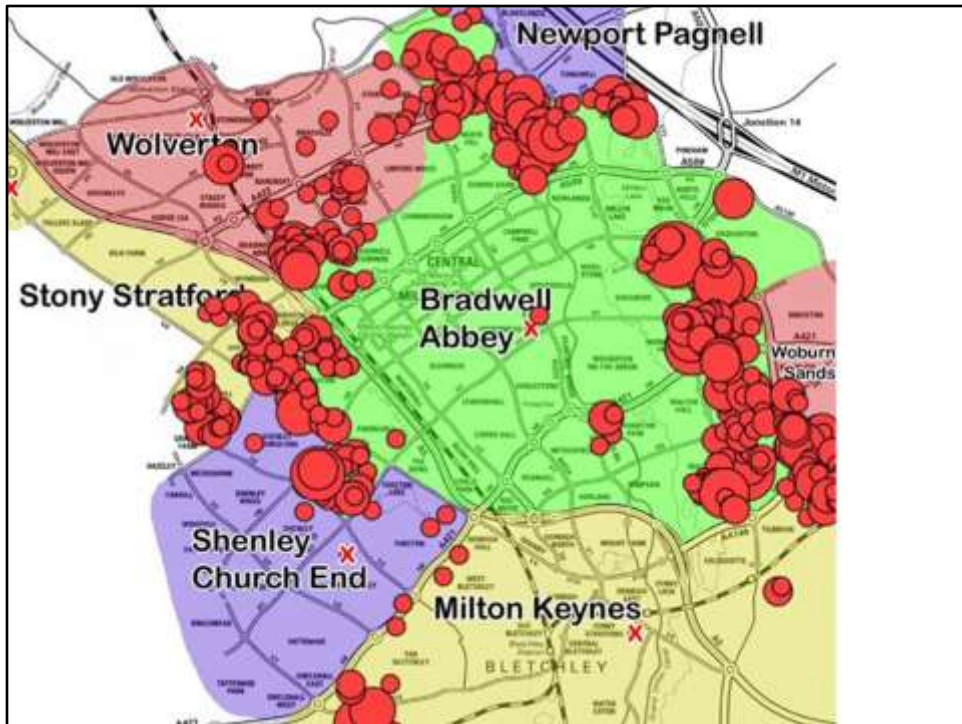

Milton Keynes is served by 7 telephone exchanges. The map is “best guess” without having unavailable BT Openreach data. It's built from reports from the action group members. Crosses show the exchange buildings – these are accurate from known information. Bradwell Abbey covers a huge area and nearly 30,000 properties! (Yes, the exchange is in Fishermead).

The distance from the exchange to the limits at Shenley Lodge, Great Linford, Broughton, Walnut Tree is up to 6.5km.



MK BAG members (old 2004 data). Each red blob represents a post code. The more members in a post code, the bigger the blob. The boundary, “the ring of fire” is up to 6.5km from the exchange in Fishermead.
